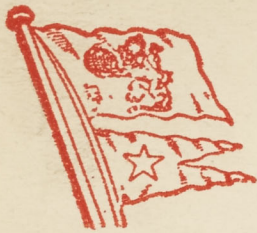

The remains of the late Mr. William Ferguson at the wish of his wife Elizabeth Ferguson were committed to the deep.

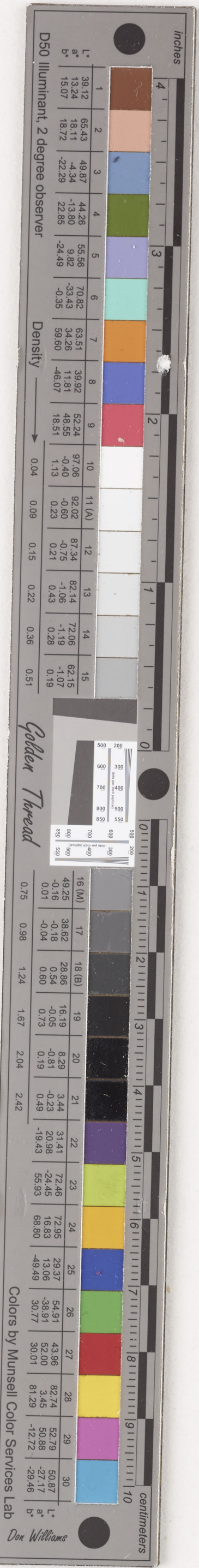
