I beg to call your attention to the  
following, abstracted from our log.

Samana Bay, Dominican Republic,  
February 1st, 1924. 10.30A.M.

I was informed by the Purser, that Mr. Ar-  
thur C. Denison, a passenger from New York  
to Santo Domingo, D R., was missing. On in-  
quiry I found that he was last seen and spe-  
ken to by the 3rd Assistant Engineer around  
1.50A.M., (Friday February 1st). On leaving  
him he entered the saloon door amidships,  
and was seen by the night watchman walking  
through the saloon about the same time.  
The ship was thoroughly searched but no trace  
of him could be found.
