*John Carroll* of the City of New York, in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other good and valuable considerations to me paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do sell, assign, transfer and set over unto RICHARD vom HOFE of the City of New York, his executors, administrators and assigns, to his and their own proper use and benefit, a certain saloon liquor license herein-- after more particularly described and any and all sums of money now due from the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty of the City of New York, or to grow due upon a certain saloon liquor license issued to me on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1896, and expiring on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1897, and known and designated by the number 5261 Class 2 A.

AND I do hereby give the said RICHARD vom HOFE his executors, administrators and assigns, the full power and authority, for his own use and benefit, but at his own cost, to ask, demand, collect, receive, compound, and give acquittance for the same or any part thereof, and in his name or otherwise to prosecute and withdraw any suits or proceedings at law or in equity therefor.

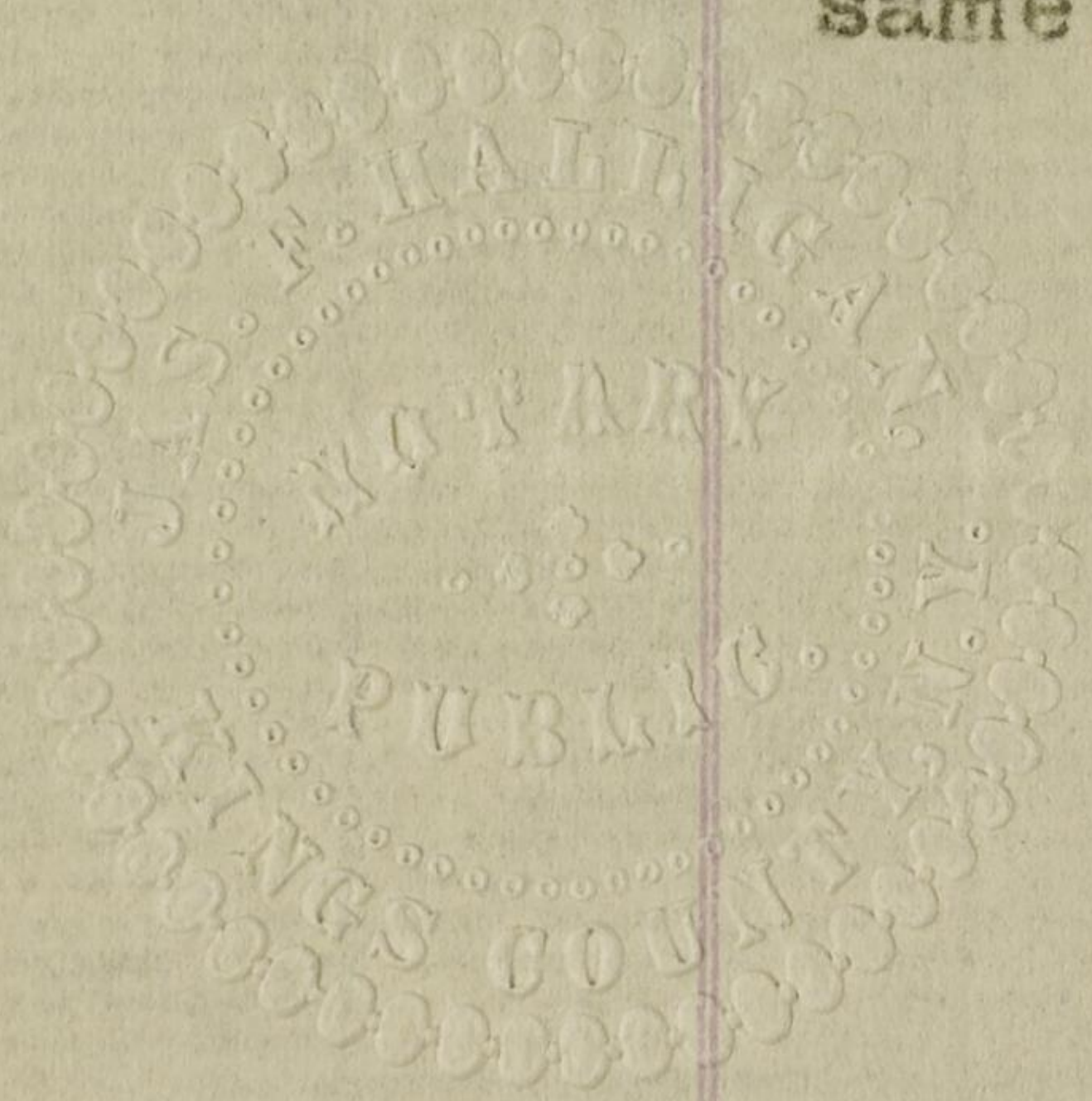

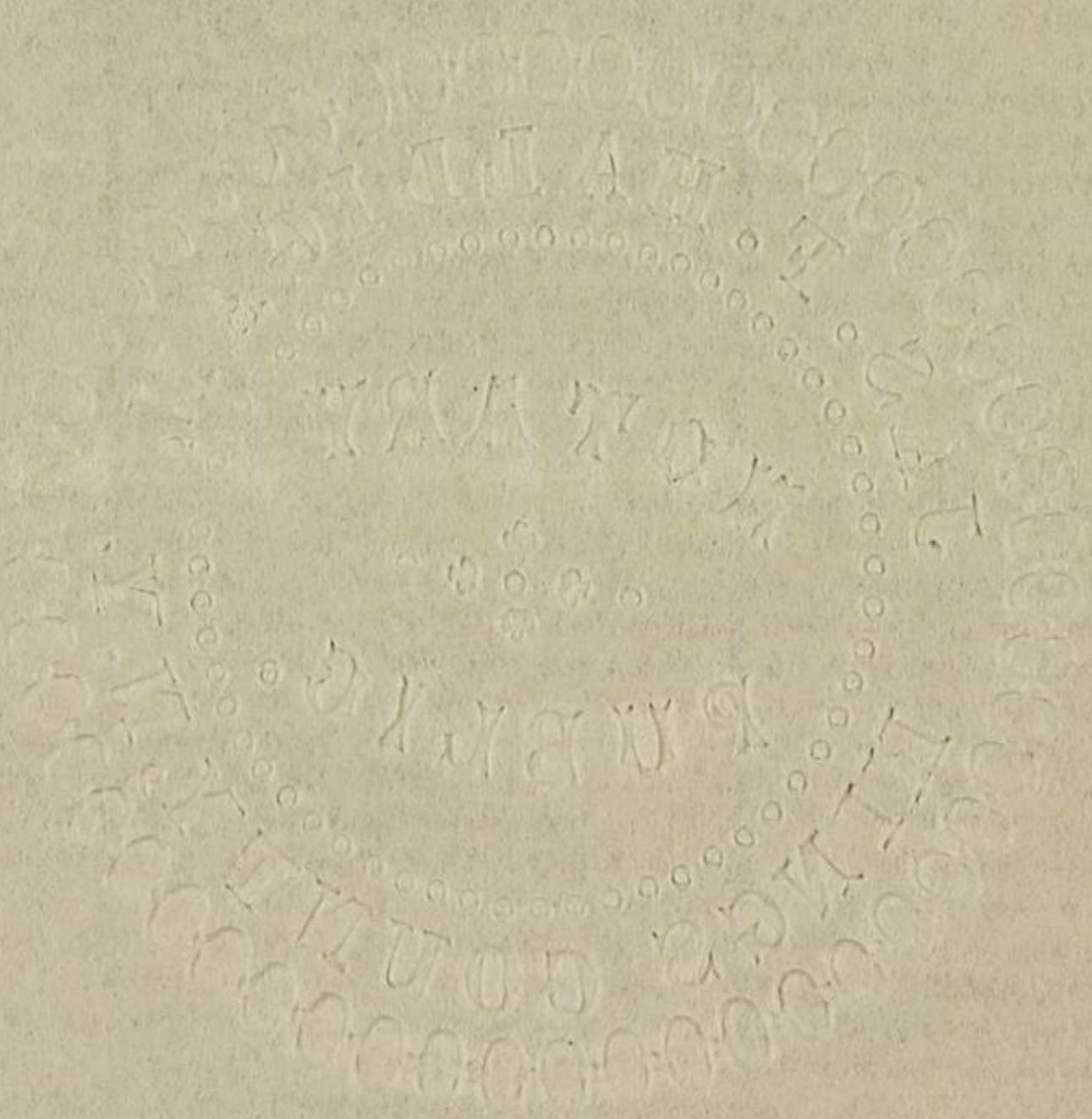


