
Dear Sirs,

NETHERLANDS AMERICAN STEAM NAVIGATION COMPANY.

Extract from Log Book, kept on board S. S. "POTSDAM",
containing the certificate of death of Herschel Czibelman.

On this, the 19th day of May, nineteen hundred and nine, on board of the aforesaid steamship, then being in Latitude 49 degrees 34 minutes North and Longitude 17 - 54 West, before me, Bote Gosse Bruinsma, Master of said vessel, appeared Bernard aged 29, Hartogh Heys (and Maarten Jacobus Jansen, aged 24, who declared that Herschel Czibelman, a third class passenger, lastly domiciled at New York, State of New York, U. S. A., died on May 19th, nineteen hundred and nine, at 10.30 A. M., on board of the aforesaid vessel, at the age of 40 years, husband of Leie Czibelman, son of: parents names unknown, both deceased.

Of which we have drawn up this certificate, and signed it with the appearance^{er}, after it had been read.




