Frank Gaccaro of the CRIME OF ASSAULT IN THE FIRST DEGREE, committed as follows:

The said Frank Gaccaro

late of the City of New York, in the County of New York aforesaid, on the twenty-sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety, with force and arms, at the City and County aforesaid, in and upon the body of one Rocco Cifuno in the Peace of the said People then and there being, feloniously did make an assault and with a certain

which the said Frank Gaccaro in his right hand then and there had and held, the same being a deadly and dangerous weapon, wilfully and feloniously did strike, beat, cut, stab and wound,

with intent to kill the said Rocco Cifuno thereby then and there feloniously and wilfully to kill, against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of the People of the State of New York and their dignity.

SECOND COUNT—

AND THE GRAND JURY AFORESAID, by this indictment, further accuse the said Frank Gaccaro of the CRIME OF ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE, committed as follows:

The said Frank Gaccaro

late of the City and County aforesaid, afterwards, to wit: on the day and in the year aforesaid, at the City and County aforesaid, with force and arms, in and upon the body of the said Rocco Cifuno in the peace of the said People then and there being, wilfully and wrongfully make another assault, and with a certain razor the said

which the said Frank Gaccaro in his right hand then and there had and held, the same being a weapon and an instrument likely to produce grievous bodily harm, then and there feloniously did wilfully and wrongfully strike, beat, cut, stab and wound, against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of the People of the State of New York, and their dignity.
