I, James Thomas Robinson of the City of New York, hereby charge,

SAMUEL KREISER, A LICENSED AUCTIONEER,

of the City of New York, having an Auction Room at No:9 West 28th. Street in said city under Sections 113, 1992, 1993 and 1994 of the Consolidation Act and 443 of the Penal Code, with the following violations of the law regulating auctions and auctioneers in the City of New York.

1. That on the 6th. day of March 1896, at a sale conducted by him at his said Auction Room at No:9 West 28th. I do most respectfully demand an immediate trial of the said SAMUEL KREISER, upon said charges according to law, at which my Counsel and witnesses shall be present and prosecute the charges, and that if my charges are sustained, that the AUCTIONEER'S LICENSE granted to the said SAMUEL KREISER, be immediately revoked and his Bond forfeited and he be committed for trial according to law, and in accordance with the provision of Sections 1994 and 113 of the Consolidation Act.

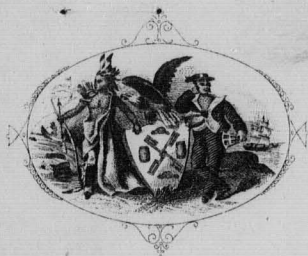

Dear Mr. Battle:--

As I told you this morning, I would like to have the matter mentioned below brought before the Grand Jury, if you think it proper. I am anxious that this be done to-morrow if possible, as I understand that one of the witnesses is about to leave town.

Simon Greenbaum, a brother-in-law of my client Morris Greenbaum, did business in this City some two years ago and failed. He returned to this City a short time ago, and commenced to do some business for his brother, Morris Greenbaum. For the latter he attended a sale at the auction rooms of John Nicholson, 152 Canal St., on April 21st. At this sale, Simon Greenbaum bid off and purchased, for his brother, the following articles -

1 Hunting gold watch, 14 k. . . .	\$ 26.
1 Gold chain, 14 k.	16.50
1 Pair large diamond earrings, /	.122.
1 Diamond stud,78.50
1 Five stone diamond ring,42.50
1 Pair smaller diamond earrings, .	.45.75
1 Diamond cluster,	20. <u>\$351.25</u>

He told Nicholson's bookkeeper to make out the bill in the name of Morris Greenbaum. A discount of 3 per cent was allowed for cash, leaving the amount to be paid \$340.72. The bill was made out, and Simon Greenbaum thereupon paid to Nicholson the \$340.80 in cash. This cash was the property of Morris Greenbaum. Nicholson retained the cash and refused to deliver the goods, on the ground that he had an old account of about \$250. against Simon Greenbaum. Greenbaum protested, but was ordered out of the place.

Nicholson still refuses to give up either the money or the property.

I understand the law to be that, even if Simon Greenbaum had been buying for himself, it would be larceny for Nichol-

son to retain the money or property under these circumstances.

Simon Greenbaum has had one or two dealings with Nicholson, during the past month, and has given him cheques payable to the order of Morris Greenbaum, and endorsed over to Nicholson, so that the latter must have known that Simon was acting for his brother. These cheques were the cheques of third parties.

Nicholson was brought before Judge Simms on summons yesterday, but was discharged, the Judge holding, as I understand it, that there was a lack of criminal intent.

His attention was not called to the language of ~~the~~ Sec. 548 of the Penal Code, that a claim of title "shall not excuse the retention of the property of another to offset or pay demands held against him".

I am thoroughly satisfied myself that Nicholson is guilty of larceny. I called to see him shortly after the occurrence on April 21st. He was not in, but the bookkeeper, who participated in the transaction, was quite insolent. He did not care whether it was against the law or not. He said Simon Greenbaum owed them this money and they were going to keep it anyway and the property too.

During the night of May 19th last between eleven and one o'clock, one Adolph Glancz sold out the contents of his store at 79 Mott St. for Nine hundred and Fifty dollars. He was a leather dealer with a number of creditors in the Swamp. The purchaser, we are informed was one Jacob Doblin, a licensed auctioneer. The reasonable value of the property was from Twenty-five hundred to Three thousand dollars. The transaction was carried on without the knowledge of Glancz's creditors, who have since looked in vain for the money due to them. It is reported that Glancz took passage for Europe the next day.

Between five and six o'clock on the morning of May 20th the contents of the store were removed to an unoccupied store in an obscure neighborhood on the east side. A small part of the goods was there replevined by the rightful owners, and the balance hurriedly removed therefrom, and disposed of as we are informed by the said auctioneer for whatever prices he could obtain for the goods.

Glancz conducted his business in the ordinary way up

to Saturday evening May 16th. His store was closed on May 18th and 19th, which were as we believe Jewish holidays, so that Glanz's creditors had nothing to excite their suspicion until the morning of May 20th when the store was found to be vacant and deserted.

It is perhaps not necessary at this time to characterize this transaction as it deserves to be.
