lawfully issued to *me* byx the Board of Excise of the *City of*

New York on the *12* day of *Sept.* 1895, for the premises known

and described as *No. 424 First Ave. New York City*

and which said license, certificate or permit was not to terminate

until the *12th* day of *Septm.* 1896, and which said license,

certificate was terminated on June 30, 1896, by reason of Chapter

112 of the laws of 1896, and under and pursuant to the said act,

I would have entitled to receive, collect and recover from *the*

Mayor, Aldermen and Community of the City of New York such proportion of the whole license

fee paid therefor as the remainder of the time for which said li-

cense would otherwise have run, shall bear to the whole period for

which it was granted.

That at the date of the execution of this instrument, *I was* the

sole owner of the said license, certificate or permit, and that *I*


have been, since the issuance thereof, and that *I* have
