S.S. GUANTANAMO - DEATH OF AUBRY POLLARD, MESSMAN - 2/17/26

The log of our S.S. GUANTANAMO of American Register arriving New York, February 19th, 1926, indicates the death at sea on February 17th - 4.00 A.M. of one Aubry Pollard, Messman, buried at sea February 18th, 1926. Aubry Pollard is described on the articles age 25 height 5'9", colored, birth place Barbados, B.W.I.

The following entry appears in the Master's Voyage Report:

"Aubry Pollard, Messman, Feb. 17th at 4.00 A.M.
found dead in bed. Lat. 35° 15' N. Long 72°
30' W. On Feb. 18th at 5.35 A.M. was buried in
Lat. 39° 00' N. Long 73° 40' W."

We are filing this information with you for the reason that the record on file in this office shows Aubry Pollard's address to be 235 W. 140th Street, New York City.
