# Court of General Sessions of the Peace

OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF NEW YORK.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

against

*John Quinn*

The Grand Jury of the City and County of New York, by this indictment, accuse

*John Quinn* —

of the CRIME OF ROBBERY in the *second* degree, committed as follows:

The said *John Quinn*,

late of the City of New York, in the County of New York aforesaid, on the *seventeenth* day of *January*, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-*two*, in the *time of the said day*, at the City and County aforesaid, with force and arms, in and upon one *Lawrence D. Dan*, — in the peace of the said People then and there being, feloniously did make an assault; and

*the sum of three dollars in money  
lawful money of the United States  
of America, and of the value of  
three dollars,*

of the goods, chattels and personal property of the said *Lawrence D. Dan*, from the person of the said *Lawrence D. Dan*, against the will and by violence to the person of the said *Lawrence D. Dan*, — then and there violently and feloniously did rob, steal, take and carry away, *the said John Quinn* being then and there aided by an accomplice actually present, whose name is to the Grand Jury aforesaid as yet unknown. —

against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of the People of the State of New York and their dignity.
