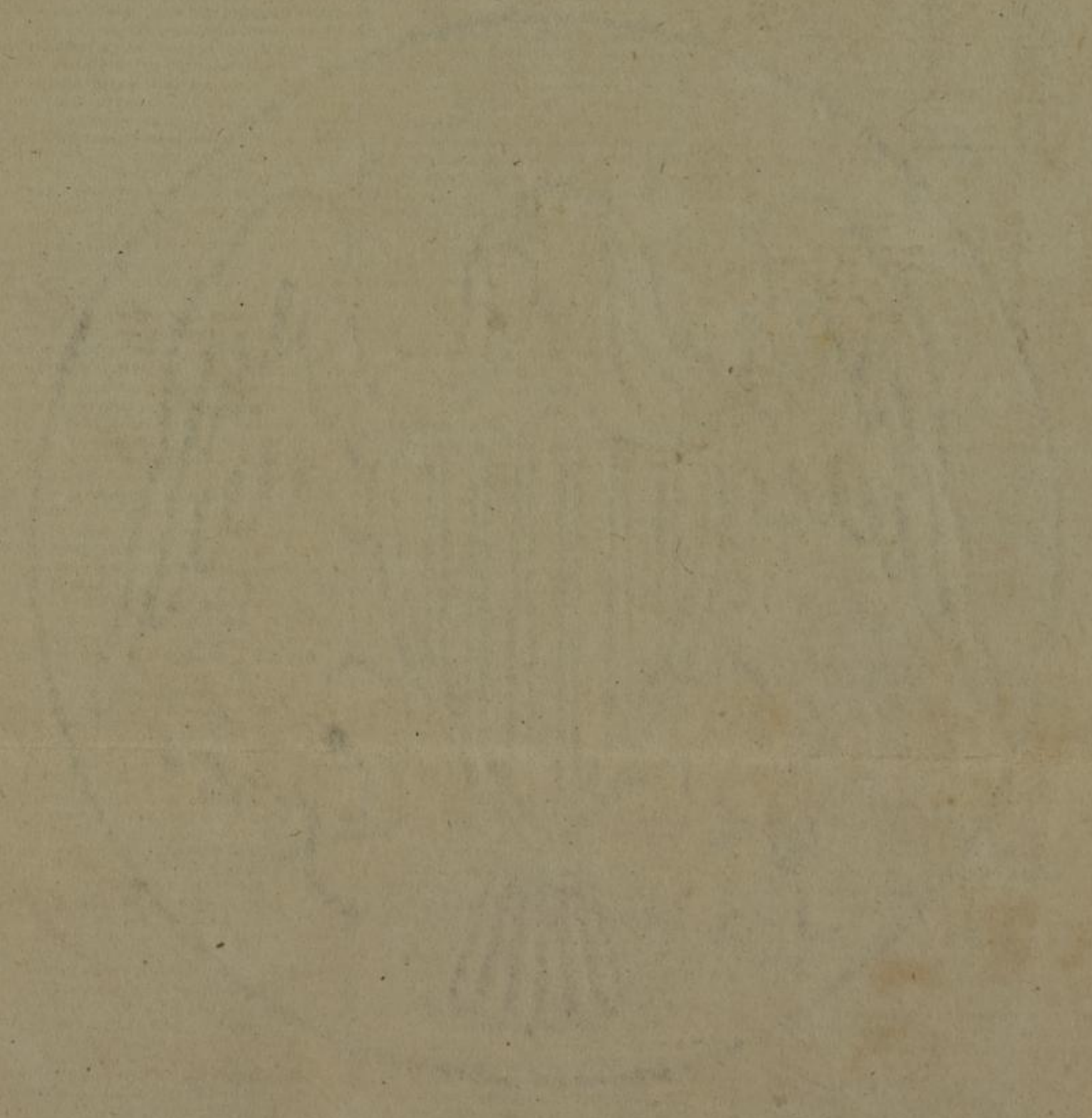

Pursuant to an Act of the Legislature of the State of New York, entitled an Act for the Encouragement of Schools passed the Ninth Day of April in the year of our Lord 1795. - We the Trustees of our School kept and Taught at Gowanus in the Township of Brooklyn, by Christopher Bennet School-Master upon Terms as follows, Namely that the said Christopher Bennet doth engage with his Employers by the Year, upon Condition of a certain Number of Scholars being furnished, and payment Quarterly made to him by his several Employers at the Rate of Twelve shillings per Quarter for every Scholar under his care and Tuition; - We do also further Certify, that the following Catalogue is a just and true Return of all the Scholars from Yellow Hook in the Township of New Utrecht who from Time to Time have been Instructed and Taught by Him, the said Christopher Bennet from the 15th Day of March 1796 until the 15th Day of March 1797 Instant, Sundays, Holy Days and Blank Days excepted as -
