of collecting dues from members who wished to pay. I heard shots
from inside the ballroom and they seemed to be coming from the
front closer to where I was. I ran into the men's room and was there
for only a short time when the realization that something may have
happened to Malcolm came over me. I then left the men's room and
went to the stage where I saw Malcolm lying shot.

were in the ballroom that day.

I am a registered nurse.
When I went up to the stage I
felt for Malcolm X's pulse. He had
none. In my opinion he was dead.
