No. *1690* - issued by the late Commissioners of Excise of the City of New York, on the *26th* day of *July* - 189*6*, to *Elizabeth Feldman* - for use upon the premises No. *208 West 27th Street* in the City of New York, *and transferred by certificate #312 to premises # 212 West 27th Street on the 20th day of April 1896.*
