

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that I,  
*Frank P. Gulbert* residing at *222 East 10<sup>th</sup> Street* in the  
*City of New York* in the County of *New York*, State of  
New York, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR and  
other valuable considerations, to me in hand duly paid by THE  
GEORGE BECHTEL BREWING COMPANY, of Stapleton, Richmond County,  
New York, do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the  
said The George Bechtel Brewing Company, all right, title and in-  
terest or rebate which I now have or may hereafter acquire  
against the *Mayor, Aldermen and Community of the City of New York*  
by reason of a certain license, certificate or permit, heretofore  
lawfully issued to me by the Board of Excise of the *City of*  
*New York* on the *4* day of *September* 189*5*, for the premises known  
and described as *167 William Street*,  
and which said license, certificate or permit was not to terminate  
until the *2<sup>d</sup>* day of *September* 189*5*, and which said license,  
certificate was terminated on June 30, 1896, by reason of Chapter  
112 of the laws of 1896, and under and pursuant to the said act,  
I would have entitled to receive, collect and recover from  
the *Mayor, Aldermen, and Community* of the *City of New York* such proportion of the whole license  
fee paid therefor as the remainder of the time for which said li-  
cense would otherwise have run, shall bear to the whole period for  
which it was granted.

That at the date of the execution of this instrument, I *was* the,  
sole owner of the said license, certificate or permit, and that I  
have been, since the issuance thereof, and that I have  
not assigned, transferred, mortgaged, sold or otherwise disposed  
of *my* right, title and interest in and to the same or any re-  
bate due thereon, and that there are no liens or encumbrances of  
any kind upon the same, and I do hereby constitute and appoint the



said The George Bechtel Brewing Company, *my* attorney, ir-  
revocable, in *my* name or otherwise, but at its own cost, to take  
all proper legal measures or proceedings for the collection thereof  
of.
