This is to certify that Philip Stenbar, Seaman, Age 43 years, native of Curacao, Dutch West Indies (Colored) while securing ship side door on starboard side of main deck aft, fell overboard and was lost. Nothing was seen of him after he fell overboard. Life ring was thrown over and ship manoeuvred around, making several circles from the hour of 12.15 p.m. until 1.35 p.m., when all hopes of saving him was given up. In the meantime, men were stationed aloft, sea being too rough to allow of lowering a life boat. 1.36 p.m vessel resumed her course not having seen the man. Inventory of deceased effects was taken, to be turned over to proper authorities

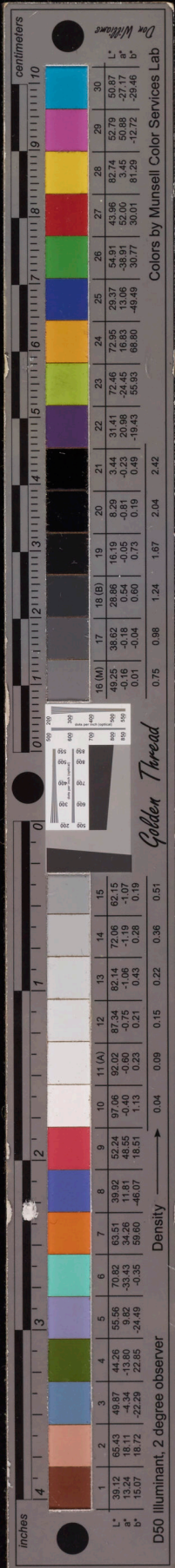
