3/23/65 I, Carl Holmes of 1365 Fifth Ave.
Apt. 6A. arrived at Auditor Ballroom
with Thomas Wheeler and Frederick Davenport
while Benjamin was speaking. We sat
down on right side near the rear, I believe
in the last row. Then Malcolm greeted the
audience and a commotion was started towards
the front by two brothers, one who said
"Get your hands out your pocket!" I did not
C.H. ~~Allegre~~ ^{see} who they were and was not paying
much attention to this. Then shots rang
out from the front of stage & I saw
Malcolm fall back. I then ducked and
went underneath a table & more shots rang
out from the direction of the front near stage.
I saw smoke from where shots came from
but did not see who was shooting and I
did not see any guns. I then got up &
went outside and saw some brothers beating
another brother; whom I couldn't ^{at the time I shot} see & I
place the person in a police car. I then left
for home with my two friends.

On 2-21-65 at Audubon Ballroom. Came with Thomas Wheeler + Frederick Davenport. arrived about 8:00 PM. sat on right near as faced stage.

Benjamin was speaking. Benjamin Malx, Malx started to speak, I then got up + said "get your hands out of my pocket," we had a brown coat, I had a shirt + lot of shots people started ducking. Shots seemed to be from front, I saw smoke from front, I saw people running, I saw none with a gun.

I joined mosque in 1961. — left 1963 ^{Dec} after Nov. I was a mosque member about a month after under left. I can remember some of the how long a member. I was squad leader for 3 months Oct/Nov/Dec. 1963 of selling papers.

Captain Joseph dismissed me because he thought my method of getting papers sold was wrong. I feel the mosque was not what I thought it was. I knew Johnson + Butler, Johnson was a Squad leader in the Bronx. Butler didn't have a rank as I knew. I knew them over slightly just could Hells. I reported the papers sold or not sold to Captain Joseph. I had about 50 men in my squad. There were 2 squads in Manhattan. First there was one + then they split it up.

1st Lt was Clarence TX. Ivory X was a Lt from Manhattan. They had investigators.

Joined Mosque # 7 in approx. 1961 asked to leave Mosque 7 in Nov. or Dec. 1963. Was a squad leader Oct. N v. Dec. 1963 in charge of selling newspapers. had about 50 men under me. Just before I was told to leave is when I was a squad commander. I was asked to leave because Captain Joseph told me I was not selling the papers right and he knew I didn't think the mosque was all it should have been. Captain Joseph told me to leave. I was in the Mosque about a month after Malcolm was dismissed from it. I went to the Muslim Mosque Inc. which Malcolm had started for religious reasons but I never joined the OAAU. But I went to several meeting they had at the Audubon Ballroom. On 2-21-65 I arrived at the Audubon Ballroom with Thomas Wheeler, and Frederick Davenport, Benjamin was speaking when we got there. We sat on the right side in the rear as you face the stage. 2 men got up from the center of the hall and one said "Get your hand out of my pocket". Then I heard allot of shots, and people running and ducking all around. Shots seemed to come from up front. I saw smoke from up front. I did not see anyone with a gun or shooting. I knew Johnson and Butler from the Mosque 7. Johnson, Thomas 15X was a squad leader in the Bronx. As far as I know Butler didn't have any rank when I left. I knew them only slightly that is to say "Hello" to and that's all. There were 2 squads in Manhattan after they had split them up from one squad. 1st. Lieutenant was Clarence 7X, Ivory X was a lieutenant from Manhattan. They used to have investigators.
