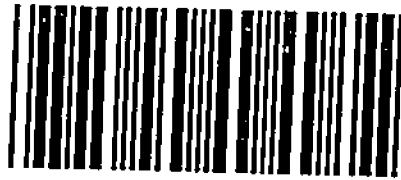

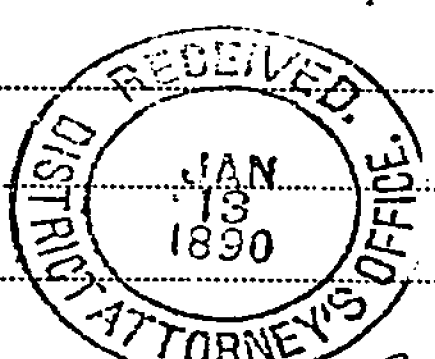

accuse

Kate Quinn

of the CRIME OF GRAND LARCENY IN THE *second* DEGREE, committed
as follows:

late of the City of New York, in the County of New York aforesaid, on the *Fifteenth*
day of *October* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *eighty-*
nine, at the City and County aforesaid, with force and arms,

*one watch of the value of
seventy-five dollars, one
chain of the value of fifty dol-
lars, one dress of the value
of fifty dollars, and diverse
articles of underclothing of a
number said description to the Grand
Jury aforesaid unknown of
the value of thirty dollars*

of the goods, chattels and personal property of one

Ellen Perrie

then and there being found, then and there feloniously did steal, take and carry away,
against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of
the People of the State of New York, and their dignity.
