

The Grand Jury of the City and County of New York, by this indictment, accuse

Alexander E. Van Rensselaer —

of the CRIME OF ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE, committed as follows:

The said *Alexander,*

late of the First Ward of the City of New York, in the County of New York aforesaid, on the ~~seventh~~ day of ~~September~~, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-~~seven~~ *six*, at the Ward, City and County aforesaid, in and upon the body of one *John R. Stodd,* in the peace of the said people then and there being, with force and arms, unlawfully did make an assault and ~~kill~~ the said *John,* did then and there unlawfully beat, wound and illtreat, to the great damage of the said *John,* against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of the People of the State of New York, and their dignity.
