Robert Inglis

of the CRIME OF ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE, committed as follows:

The said Robert Inglis

late of the City of New York, in the County of New York aforesaid, on the nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one, at the City and County aforesaid, in and upon the body of one

Patrick Burke in the peace of the said People then and there being, with force and arms, unlawfully did make an assault, and him the said Patrick Burke did then and there unlawfully beat, wound and illtreat, against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of the People of the State of New York and their dignity.
