

February 21st 1965

3:05 P.M.....Lt. Bernard Mulligan of the Bureau of Special Services was notified that Malcolm X had been shot. Lt. Mulligan assigned Detectives Kenneth Egan, Shield #2456 and Henry A. Suarez, Shield #449. The assigned detectives responded to the scene (Audubon Ballroom, went upstairs and were informed that Malcolm had been removed to the Medical Center on the 3rd floor. Egan and Suarez proceeded to the hospital where they met Detectives Cavallaro, Shield #409 and Cusmano, Shield #16245, 34th Squad.

3:12 P.M.....Detectives Cavallaro and Cusmano and Jacobbellis, Shield #589 were informed by Sgt. Aronoff, Shield #640, 30th Pct. that he had a prisoner (shot in the leg) who he believed was the perpetrator in the shooting of Malcolm X in the Audubon Ballroom. Cavallaro and Cusmano proceeded to place of occurrence, discovered that Malcolm X and two others (William Parker and William Harris) had been removed to Medical Center, 3rd floor emergency ward. Dr. Collins informed the assigned detectives that Malcolm X was DOA. William Harris was unable to be interviewed because he was suffering from a gun shot wound of the right side and was being prepared for exploratory surgery of an emergency nature.

William Parker was interviewed at this time by Detectives Cavallaro and Cusmano and he stated that he was present at the Audubon Ballroom when shots rang out. He stated that he was seated in the audience at the time and dove to the floor seeking cover and subsequently shot in the left foot. He further stated that he did not see who was doing the shooting.

3:30 P.M..... Detectives Cavallaro and Cusmano of the 34th Squad left the Medical Center and met Detectives Egan and Suarez of the Bureau of Special Services, and they informed that Malcolm X was DOA. At this time the members of the 34th Squad proceeded to the Audubon Ballroom and Detectives Egan and Suarez went to the 3rd floor of the Medical Center. Mrs. Malcolm X in the company of two unidentified females identified Malcolm X's body. After the identification, Mrs. Malcolm X departed and Suarez and Egan returned to the Audubon Ballroom.

February 21st 1965

3:35 P.M.....Detectives Cavallaro and Cusmano returned to the Audubon Ball Room and were informed by Sgt. Brennan, Shield 987, 34th Pct. who stated he found one J.C. Higgins saw-off 12 gauge, 2 3/4 inch chamber, shotgun. Model #1017 (Sear Roebuck) #5100, wrapped in a man's suit jacket. It was found lying on a table in the left rear of the stage. Detectives Cavallaro and Cusmano conducted a search of the area for possible weapons or evidence in connection with this case. Locations where evidence was found were marked off and the entire crime scene was safe guarded pending arrival of the photo unit.

3:45 P.M.....Detectives Egan and Cusmano at the direction of Inspector Reneghan returned to the hospital to secure Malcolm X's property to wit: one 1965 Red Diary which had 3 bullet holes; one tear gas pen devise "Penguin" with two TC-4 cartirdges for same, one of which was in the pen for immediate use.

4:15 P.M.....Detectives Egan and Cusmano returned to the Audubon Ballroom to continue assisting in the investigation thereat and subsequently all concerned then proceeded to the offices of the 34th Squad where the investigation is continuing.


