EXTRACT FROM LOG OF S.S. "ADVANCE"
JULY 15th. 1914

The man overboard proved to be John J. Murphy cabin passenger who when rescued was apparently dead. He was at once turned over to the ship's Surgeon who pursued all possible means of revival, artificial respiration was exercised until the doctor pronounced the patient dead, and further efforts useless. This was about 8.15 P.M.

He was lost in L. 9' 50" N. Long 79' 31" W. and buried in Lat 16' 06" N. Long 76' 53" W. He was lost overboard at about 6.10 P.M. and rescued at 6.30 P.M.
