Laws Relating to the Payment of Money for City Purposes.

NEW YORK CITY CONSOLIDATION ACT OF 1882.

SEC. 123. The Finance Department shall have control of the fiscal concerns of the Corporation. All accounts rendered to or kept in the other Departments shall be subject to the inspection and revision of the officers of this Department. It shall prescribe the forms of keeping and rendering all city accounts, and, except as herein otherwise provided, the manner in which all salaries shall be drawn, and the mode by which all creditors, officers and employees of the Corporation shall be paid. * * * *

SEC. 46. * * * * No expense shall be incurred by any of the Departments, Boards or Officers thereof, unless an appropriation shall have been previously made covering such expense, nor any expense in excess of the sum appropriated in accordance with law.

SEC. 47. It shall be the duty of the heads of all Departments of said City, and of all Boards and Officers charged with the duty of expending or incurring obligations payable out of the moneys raised by tax in said City, so to regulate such expenditures for any purpose or object, that the same shall not in any one year exceed the amount appropriated by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment for such purpose or object; and no charge, claim, or liability shall exist or arise against said City for any sum in excess of the amount appropriated for the several purposes.
