**Assignment,** Made this *Twenty sixth* day of *October*  
189*6*, by *James Hackett* party of the first part, to  
H. KOEHLER & CO., party of the second part, **Witnesseth:**

For and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

The first party hereby sells, assigns and transfers to the second party, its successors and assigns, all his right and title to and interest in the certain *Saloon* Liquor License dated the *Eighteenth* day of *February* 189*6*, issued by the Board of Excise of the City of New York to the first party for the purpose of trafficking in liquor at No. *42 Water Street*, in the City of New York, for the time for which said *Saloon* Liquor License was granted, and particularly the unexpired period or portion thereof, with full power and authority hereby given and granted to the second party, its successors and assigns, to receive, obtain and recover from the City of New York such proportion of the whole license fee paid by the first party to the City of New York, or to the Board of Excise of the City of New York, for obtaining said license, as the remainder of the time for which such license otherwise would have run, excepting for the passage of Chapter 112, Laws 1896, and thereupon to receive and collect from the City of New York, as provided by Section 4 of Chapter 112 of the Laws of 1896, or by virtue of said Act, the unexpired or unearned portion of the said license fee paid by the first party to the said City of New York, or the Board of Excise of the City of New York, granting full power and authority to the said H. Koehler & Co. to do and perform any other act or acts and thing which may be required or necessary to secure and obtain the rights, privileges, moneys and funds hereby assigned.




