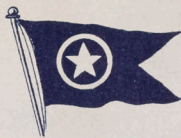

DEATH CERTIFICATE - MR. FRANK WAGNER

We send you herewith signed copy of Certificate of Death of Frank Wagner, a member of crew of the T.E.L. ORIENTE aboard the vessel in the harbor of Havana, Cuba, March 9, 1941.

This Certificate is sent to you inasmuch as the address of Frank Wagner, as appearing in our records, is 24 Cooper Street, New York City, c/o Aunt, Mrs. J. Hanna. However, for your information, on March 9 we sent our representative to 24 Cooper Street and were informed that Mrs. Hanna moved some time ago. We have been unable so far to ascertain her present address or names and addresses of other relatives of the deceased. The body was buried in the City of Havana on March 9 or 10, 1941.
