After back in, John D assigned
him to front restroom. This before
Benjamin spoke.

On left side of Stage as
you face stage. Robert 35 X (Smith)
posted at stage on opposite side.

Robert gave for 1/2 hr then
relieved while Benjamin speaking.
Relieved in military manner by
2 other men reported to found
in rear. Then sat in rear.

then walked around. At
about 3 PM. W and Rower 35x
relieved Stage Guards. Regular
Assignment to relieve at 1 1/2
hour. Went to same side of
stage. Benjamin still speaking.
Mal. introduced.

Mal said Saloon Clerk.
now jumped up - set your hand
on my pocket. To another
man, sort of a scuffle. Gelling
to man on his right.

This in view of audience.
W stepped one step off and looked.
heard a pop sound
from the back.

Then heard that.

Identified Band in front
row, saw them running at
Center door. First back and to
left and right.

Doesn't know if anyone
went to stage and shot.
The Box ran into Ladies
Room.

Freddie was seated in

4th or 5th row, ~~you~~ Reddin
pinned out Shotgun. W
picked it up in his hand
checked ~~the~~ Gun's Coat,
Brown or Brown, gave it
to Reuben x. The other everything
died down. Found a Gun
looked like a Luger, about
10 ft from Shotgun. Wrapped
Luger in a coat found on the
floor gave it to Brother
Jean. (idem picture)

shots. Then I recognized a fellow running across the room toward the ladies room. He was wearing a suit & tie. I don't recall any amount, his eyes were flying as panicked. The man was Thomas 15x Johnson. I first saw him running from the middle of the seats on ~~the~~ ^{side to state} right toward the ladies room & he was scared. I can't tell how many shots were fired, but I tell if anyone did a duck & run up to stage behind me or side of me or front below me. Next thing I see is 2 men running back toward ^{up} center aisle toward rear firing guns (Hazen & Bulter). I picked up a shotgun near center aisle when Fred Williams pointed it to me. Fred was sitting in the 4th or 5th row near the center aisle. I took off my coat (Wicks) ^{on Brown} brown checked w/ brown. I wrapped the shotgun with a jacket & gave it to Leuben Francis this was after everything had died down. I found a luger about 10 feet away from the shotgun. I wrapped the luger in a light Benjie trench coat & gave it to Brother Gene. I don't know if Leuben was chasing anyone.

I did see Robert 16x + Lynwood 15x there that day.
Robert 16x is secretary in Patterson mosque.

John D. asked me to take a security post 2-21-65 4 foot restroom.
While on the way to Audubon turning up Broadway we saw Malcolm X
waiting for a cab (Faddy ^{with arms} was driving) we picked him up at
146 & Broadway. We drove Mal X to the Audubon. Mal X entered on W 166 St
front entrance.

I was on the right of restroom facing the audience. Robert 35x
was on the left side facing audience. We stood there from 2 to 2³⁰ PM.
Two men relieved us in military manner at 2³⁰ PM. I don't recall who
the brothers were who relieved us. I know they were brothers. I went
to the rear, & reported to John D., & reported as far as I could see
"everything was all right," then I sat in the back & walked around
a little. At 3 PM Robert 35x & I relieved the men from the
front. It was scheduled for 5 hour reliefs of front restroom.
Robert & I were on the same positions. Brother Benjamin was
still speaking, Benjamin then introduced Malcolm X. Mal X greeted
the crowd "Salon Alcazar". Then there was a scuffle. This was
the first I heard, a man jumped up forced a man seated
to his ^{right} ~~right~~ (close to center aisle) in my line of seats
which were to my right as I look at audience, & stated
"Get your hands out of my pocket." The man was about 5'6
was black. I took a step off toward him & looked. I wasn't
supposed to move, so I didn't. Then I heard a pop. I was
coming from something in the back it seemed. Then I heard a volley of
