The Grand Jury of the City and County of New York, by this indictment, accuse

*James Quinn*

of the CRIME OF ASSAULT IN THE THIRD DEGREE, committed as follows:

The said

*James Quinn*

late of the City of New York, in the County of New York aforesaid, on the *eleventh*  
day of *March* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
*eighty-ninety*, at the City and County aforesaid, in and upon the body of one *Daniel*  
*Ergott* in the peace of the said People then and there being, with force  
and arms, unlawfully did make an assault, and *him* the said *Daniel*  
*Ergott* did then and there unlawfully beat, wound and ill-treat, to the great damage  
of the said *Daniel Ergott* against the form of the  
statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace of the People of the State of  
New York and their dignity.
