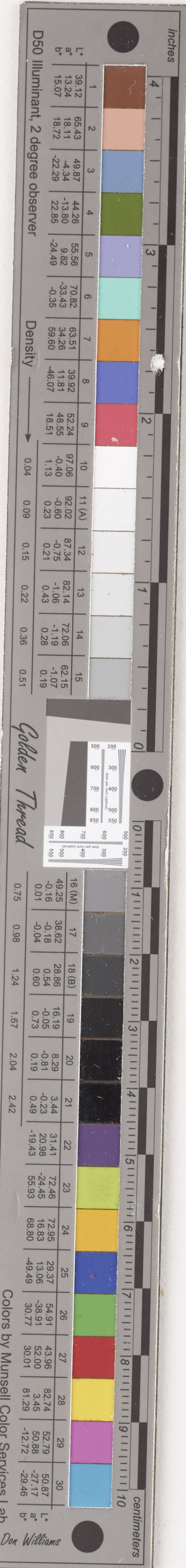

Certificate of Death.

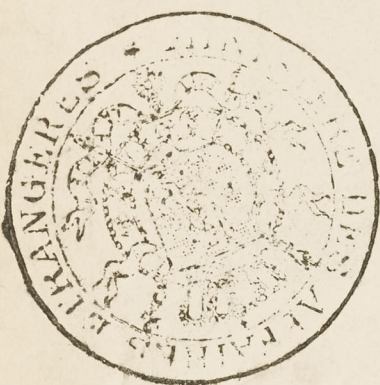
Friday the twenty sixth day of July nineteen hundred and one Lat 15.52 N Long 61.53 W. at twelve o'clock in the morning has been drawn up by us William Henry Stapledon Captain Belgian Steamer Hevelius the death act of John Americo Gombara ten month old born in New-York U. S. America and residing before embarking in Rio de Janeiro died on board the before named vessel this twenty sixth day of July nineteen hundred and one at ten o'clock in the morning child of Nicolas Gombara Father aged thirty eight years and Jennie Gombara mother aged twenty eight years both Steerage passengers on before named vessel. We after being assured of the death of the above named and following the declaration of John Mc Guire Surgeon aged forty years and David Davies Purser aged forty four years both present on board who after reading of the present act have signed with us.
