KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That *I Oscar Hippe* of the City of New York for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration to me in hand paid by *Albert O. Bogert* the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, assigned, transferred and set over unto the said *Albert O. Bogert* his executors, administrators or assigns a *Liquor* license issued by the Board of Excise of the City of New York on the *8* day of *July*, 1895, to *Oscar Hippe* to sell *Liquor* on premises No. *139 South Avenue* and numbered *1531*, which expires on the *6* day of *July* 1896, together with all claims and demands against the City of New York for rebate of or for a proportionate share of the fees paid for said license or otherwise and I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint the said *Albert O. Bogert* as my lawful attorney irrevocable, and in my name or otherwise, but at his own cost, to collect, sue for and receive any and all moneys payable by virtue of the premises, and I do hereby covenant and warrant that I am the sole and exclusive holder and owner of the said license or any claim thereunder and that neither the said license or any claim thereunder or any part thereof has been surrendered, hypothecated, assigned or otherwise disposed of, the warranty and statement as aforesaid being made as an inducement for the payment of the consideration paid therefor.
