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G I L B E R T H E N R Y, Patrolman, New

York City Police Department, called as  
a witness, having been first duly sworn,  
testified as follows:

BY MR. STERN:

Q Would you give your name, shield and assignment please officer?

A Patrolman Gilbert Henry, shield #3916, 34th Precinct.

Q Now, Patrolman Henry, directing your attention to Sunday, February 21, 1965, were you on duty approximately three o'clock in the afternoon?

A I was, sir.

Q And what was your position?

A The Audubon Ballroom.

Q Now, were you actually inside the Ballroom itself?

A Yes, I was. Well --

Q Go ahead.

A Not the main ballroom, the ballroom to the left which is the Rose Room.

Q And you were in full uniform at that time, is that correct?

A I was.

Q Now, as you stood in the ballroom to the left, did something occur at about three o'clock or a little thereafter?

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A Yes, it did.

Q What happened?

A There was a series of shots fired.

Q And where did you go after you heard the shots?

A Well, I was assigned to a walkie-talkie, and I picked up the walkie-talkie --

Q You made a report into it, is that right?

A That is correct.

Q After you finished making your report, did you go someplace?

A Yes, I went into the main ballroom.

Q That would be the Audubon Ballroom, itself, is that correct?

A That's right.

Q And at the time you got into the Audubon Ballroom was any more shots being fired?

A One more as I was coming in.

Q Could you tell where that was coming from?

A No, I did not.

Q You didn't hear any more shooting after

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that, is that correct?

A No, sir.

Q And after you came inside the Audubon Ballroom did there come a time when you went up to the stage?

A Yes, sir.

Q And what if anything did you see on the stage?

A I saw a figure lying on the stage with -- shirt opened and bullet holes around the heart.

Q And were there people around this figure lying on the stage?

A Yes, there were.

Q Now, Patrolman, did there come a time thereafter that you went to the City Morgue and there at identified the body of the man that you saw lying on the stage to the Medical Examiner?

A Yes, sir, there was.

MR. STERN: Thank you very much.

(Witness excused.)
