

TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK  
COUNTY OF NEW YORK:

The petition of CHARLES T. BEAVERS for a writ of habeas corpus respectfully shows to this Court and alleges:

1. That he is an attorney at law and that he is the attorney for THOMAS JOHNSON, who is presently detained in the custody of the Warden of the City Prison, New York County.
2. That the cause of pretense of the detention is a commitment by a Judge of the <sup>Criminal</sup> Civil Court of the City of New York, committing the relator to the Wardens custody without bail on a charge of "HOMICIDE" and "CONSPIRACY".
3. That a Court or a Judge of the United States does not have exclusive jurisdiction to order the release of the said person.
4. That the imprisonment and restraint of the relator is illegal, the manner of the illegality being that the relator was arraigned on the 4th day of March, 1965, as the result of an alleged shooting of one MALCOLM X LITTLE, by the relator, and a number of other persons.



The relator herein is detained on a short affidavit made by Detective John Keeley of the New York City Police Department, a copy of which is annexed hereto and made part hereof, based wholly on hearsay, and the relator has been confined under said complaint since March 4th, 1965, a total of seven (7) days, which is greatly in excess of forty-eight (48) hours permitted by law.

Deponent categorically states and avers to this Court that on the 5th day of March, as well as on the 8th and 10th days of March, 1965, when relator appeared before the Court, the deponent himself, as attorney for the relator objected to an adjournment, informing the Court that the relator was ready for a hearing, and objecting to any adjournment, deponent was overruled, and the matter was further adjourned to Friday, March 12th 1965.

The relator detention under the circumstances herein described is arbitrary, unlawful and in violation of the relators constitutional rights.

5. That the said THOMAS JOHNSON has not been committed and is not detained by virtue of any final judgment or decree, or any final order, mandate or process specified in Section 1231 of the Civil Practice Act of the State of New York.

6. That no previous application has been made for the relief sought herein.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that a writ of habeas corpus issue, directed to the Warden of the City Prison, New York County, requiring him to produce the said THOMAS JOHNSON before a Justice of this Court, at a Criminal Term thereof on the        day of March, 1965, at the Courthouse, located at 100 Centre Street, Borough of Manhattan, County of New York, City and State of New York.



MEMORANDUM TO THE LEGAL STAFF

FROM H. RICHARD UVILLER

RE: PEOPLE v. WILSON, et al.

The Court of Appeals considered five cases in which indefinite sentences had been imposed on misdemeanor convictions pursuant to Article 7A of the Correction Law. In the absence of an affirmative finding by the sentencing court that the defendant was not capable of reformation, the Court of Appeals had no option but to affirm each judgment, including one imposed on a defendant who had been arrested no less than twenty-one times for various crimes.

The Chief Judge, however, writing for the court, admitted that like other courts, the high court had "difficulties aplenty" in passing upon the use of this type of sentence. The court acknowledged that in many instances a 7A sentence is utilized to obtain a longer period of detention in derogation of its true purpose and deemed "the whole matter of sentencing under Article 7A" unsatisfactory. The court recommended "the attention of the legislature."

[Actually, the legislature by enacting the new Penal Law has superceded the 7-A misdemeanor sentence; see §60.00(1)].
