The following entry appears in the Captain's Voyage
Report Book, S.S. MEXICO, Voyage 310, which arrived in New York, January
19th, 1925:

"Tampico, Wednesday, January 7th, at
8.30 A.M., Peter Tressler, Watertender,
age 38, died of pneumonia, having been
sick one day. He was a citizen of the
United States.
He was attended by ship's Doctor, A
physician from Tampico also had been
consulted.
He was buried in Tampico Cemetery at
5.30 P.M. the same day.
Captain and available officers and crew
attended the funeral".
