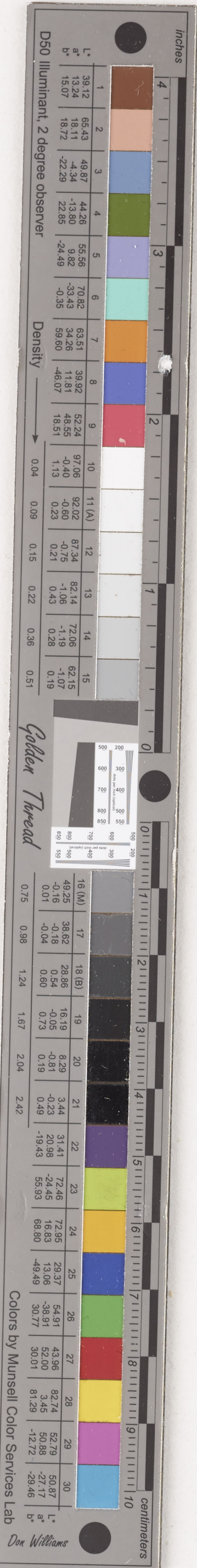

INSTRUCTIONS TO MASTERS.

A **record** of every birth of a child or death of a person on board ship is required to be made by the Master (or person in charge) of every British ship (excepting Colonial ships within the jurisdiction of the Government of the British Possession to which they belong) and of every Foreign ship carrying passengers to or from the United Kingdom.

A **return** of the facts recorded is to be delivered to a Superintendent, or British Consular or Colonial Officer, at the earliest opportunity, for transmission to the Registrar General of Shipping and Seamen.

Failure to comply with these requirements renders the Master liable to a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds for each offence. (Sections 254 and 339, Merchant Shipping Act, 1894.)

It is important that the return on this form should be an **EXACT COPY** of the entry in the tabular form in the Official Log Book (if any).

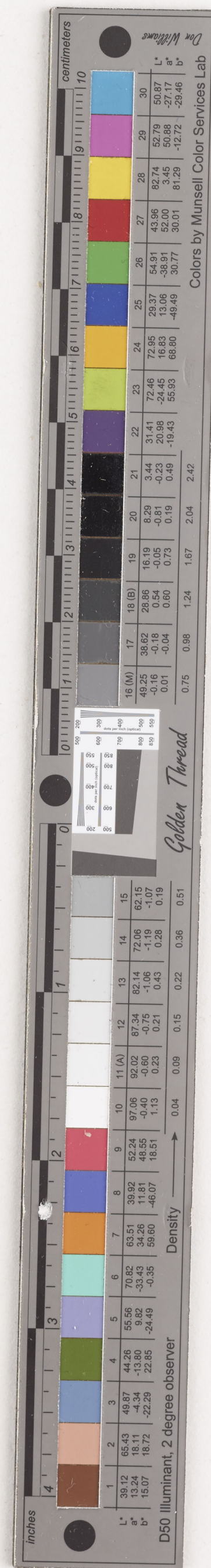
INSTRUCTIONS TO SUPERINTENDENTS, CONSULS, AND COLONIAL OFFICERS.

It is of especial importance that all essential information concerning any death should be obtained on the first opportunity after the occurrence, before any witness to the event has left the ship.

This return should be transmitted to the Registrar General of Shipping and Seamen with as little delay as possible, and the fact of its receipt and transmission should be endorsed on the Ship's Articles by the Officer transmitting it.

If any Master fails to deliver this return upon the first opportunity after the occurrence of a birth or death, the fact should be endorsed on the Ship's Articles and reported to the Board of Trade.

A return is also required to be made on pages 2 and 3 in the case of a seaman who dies out of the United Kingdom after he has ceased to be a member of the crew. In such cases the certificate on page 3 should be amended if no entry has been made in the tabular form in the official Log Book, and additional particulars should be entered at the bottom of page 4 of this form.

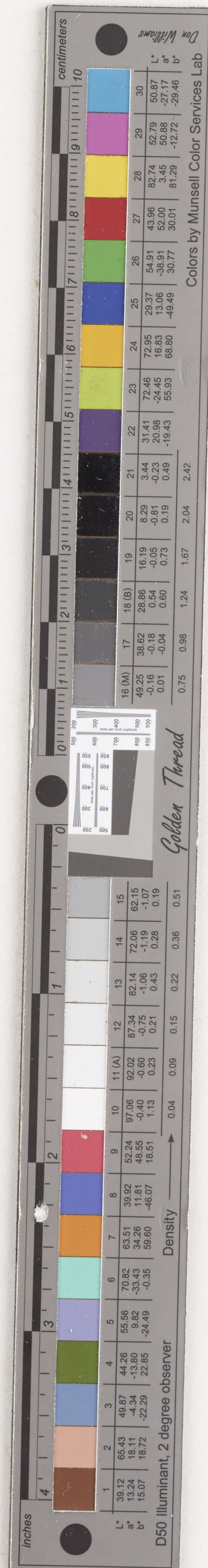
