



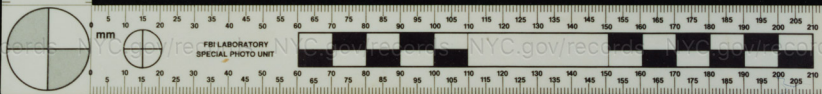

For size and weight limitations see instructions under "Surface Parcel Post".

SURFACE PARCELS: Effective January 1, 1924, fourth-class or parcel-post matter sent by surface mail in the United States, of the first, second, third, or fourth class, and of the first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth, or tenth zone, shall be limited in size to 72 inches in length and girth combined, and the limit of weight will be 40 pounds if for delivery in the local, or first or second zone and 20 pounds if for delivery in the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, or eighth zone except that these limitations shall not apply to parcels containing baby food, live plants, trees, shrubs, agricultural commodities, or books and other items mailed at the reduced rate or any parcel rate or the limited delivery rate or to any parcel or article of mail matter for delivery on any rural or star route, regardless of the class of the office of mailing or address.

The reduced limits of size and weight also do not apply to registered or insured articles, or to articles in a United States post office, or to or from any rural station, or any post office, station, or branch at any other place outside the continental United States, in a United States possession or Territory, an Army, Air Force or Navy post office, or a post office in the United States, or to articles mailed at any other place outside the continental United States where the domestic mail service is in operation, nor to articles mailed at any post office in the United States where the international mail service is in operation, nor to items mailed at the educational material rate or at the library material rate, regardless of where mailed.

Note — Parcels over 84 inches in length and girth combined, and less than 16 lb. in weight must be prepaid at 10 lbs. per cubic foot. Parcels over 84 inches in length and girth combined (except parcels over 84 inches in length and girth combined) are mailable only at post office (transfer) post offices and letterbox, named or numbered stations.

Parcels must bear the return card of the sender otherwise they will not be accepted for mailing. Fourth-class matter may be insured or sent C. O. D. up to a maximum of \$200 (per parcel).

Library boxes, for the transportation of books, for "up to 70 lbs." except that the third or fourth-class rates shall apply, where the library book rate is lower than at the library book rate.

FOREIGN MAIL MATTER

LETTERS: 11 cents first ounce and 7 cents for each additional ounce or fraction thereof, except Canada and Mexico.

POST CARDS: Single 7 cents double 14 cents, to all foreign countries except Canada and Mexico and the following United States possessions:

Baker Island, Canal Zone, Canton Island, Caroline Islands, Easterday Island, Guam, Hawaiian Islands, Jarvis Island, Johnston Island, Line Islands, Midway Islands, Mariana Islands, Marshall Islands, Midway Islands, Samoa Island, Porto Rico, Saint Croix Island, Saint John Island, Saint Thomas Island, Swains Island, Trust Territory of the Pacific, Virgin Islands (U. S.), Wake Island.

To Canada, Mexico and the United States possessions listed in the foregoing paragraph the rates are the same as for domestic rates.

Note: Pictures and souvenir post cards without a message are not subject to postage. A group of not more than 5 cards may be sent at the reduced rate of 10 cents for each card, plus 1 cent for each additional 2 one or fraction.

Registry loss (in addition to regular flat class postage), up to a maximum delivery limit of \$10,000. Payment of a higher fee.

AIR MAIL — Domestic Air Mail postage rate is \$ for each ounce or fraction thereof, regardless of distance or weight, up to and including 10 lbs. and 10 cents in excess thereof.

For the Armed Forces, the rate of postage is \$ for each ounce or fraction thereof, up to and including 8 ounces. The rate of \$ for the flat pound (over 8 ounces) is for parcels and mail not exceeding 10 lbs. and 10 cents in excess thereof shall apply. Armed Forces stamps of weight (See your Postmaster).

This figure includes all transportation to and from the various routes which now reach directly or indirectly, most of the important cities in the country.

All Air Mail may be sent Special Delivery and it is recommended for late afternoon, week end and holiday arrivals.

Although Air Mail is used mainly for letters, any mailable matter up to 70 pounds in weight and not exceeding 100 inches in length and girth combined, may be carried (excepting such articles as are subject to damage by handling).

Insure that Air Mail may be readily identified by the use of the P. O. Department upon the use of distinctive Air Mail stamps and distinctive Air Mail envelopes. The horizontal lines on the envelope and the use of the word "AIR MAIL" (parallelgram borders) or similar printed words.

Ordinary envelopes are used if it is recommended that two horizontal blue lines be drawn across the envelope, not less than 1 1/2 inch from the top. The stamps must be placed in the upper right hand corner of the envelope, not less than 1 inch from the top and 1 inch from the right side, if otherwise conforming to third or fourth class requirements.

All Air Mail may be registered.
