My name is Hattie Huff I live at 620 Cortland Ave. Bx.
Apt. 2.

On Feb. 21 1965 at about 3PM I was present in the Audobon Ballroom an unknown man was speaking and then Malcom came out to speak. Malcom came out to speak said something and held up his hand. I Heard a commotion to the rear of me and chairs falling on the floor and people starting to yell its a bomb its a bomb and then I fell on the floor. I did not recognize any of the people in the commotion or who yelled its a bomb. I stayed on the floor I heard shooting I stayed there till the shooting was over I then got up and left.

I looked at pictures shown to me by Det. Keeley I could not say if they were there or were not there at the time of the shooting.
