being class 2 A and numbered 5845 issued to me by the
Board of Excise of the City of New York dated the 13 day of March
1896, authorizing me to sell strong and spiritous liquors, wines, ale
and beer in quantities less than five gallons at a time at premises
North E. Co. Kingsbridge Road NW 185th Street, which license was issued for the term
expiring the 13th day of March 1897, but expired on
the 30th day of June, 1896, by Operation of Chapter 112 of the Laws of
1896 known as "The Liquor Tax Law" and I hereby assign, transfer and
set over unto the said party of the second part the moneys due me under
the said license from the City of New York for the unexpired term thereof
from June 30th, 1896, and I hereby nominate and appoint the party of the
second part my Attorney, irrevocable in my name or otherwise to ask, de-
mand, sue for or otherwise collect the moneys due under the said license
and to give good and valid receipts therefor.
