That heretofore to wit on the sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy six at the City and County of New York, one Samuel B. Allen did then and there marry one Mary Jane Fulsome, and her the said Mary Jane Fulsome did then and there have for his wife -

And the jurors aforesaid upon their oath aforesaid do further present that Charles Anthony Hall late of the first Ward of the City of New York in the County of New York aforesaid on the fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight at the Ward City and County aforesaid, well knowing the premises aforesaid, and that he the said Samuel B. Allen was then and there living and in full life, and was then and there the lawful husband of her the said Mary Jane Fulsome on the day and in the year aforesaid at the City and County of New York with force and arms did feloniously marry and have as his wife the said Mary Jane Fulsome, and to her the said Mary Jane Fulsome was then and there married against the form of the Statute in such case made out provided and against the peace of the people of the State of New York and their dignity
