My Name is Laura Mills I live at 620 Cortland Ave. Bx. Apt.#2

On Feb. 21, 1965 at about 3PM I was present in the Audobon Ballroom an unknown man was speaking and then Malcom come out to speak said something and held up his hand. I Heard a commotion to the rear of me and chairs falling on the floor and people starting to yell "Its a bomb Its a bomb. and then I fell on the floor and I heard shots I did not recognize any of the people in the comotion or who yelled its a bomb or see anyone shooting. After the shooting stopped I got up and left.

I looked at pictures shown to me by Det. Keeley I could not say if they were there or were not there at the time of the shooting.
