Never been a member of the Muslim Mosque #7.  
I was an admirer of Malcolm X but never was an  
official member. First contact with Malcolm was in  
Oct/64 when I got out of the Army he was speaking  
at Audubon Ballroom. I have been to Malcolm  
mosque at Hotel Theresa about 12 times. I am a  
Muslim & have attended Muslim meetings at  
the Nations of Islam on W 72 St + others. I have  
heard Malcolm speak many times.

Oct 2-21-65 I was at the Audubon Ballroom. I  
arrived at 13:00 - Came alone. Found some brother who  
was standing near the entrance. I spoke to John DX  
he told me I would take a part. My part was to be  
in front of stage on the left side as you look at  
stage. I was returned for that part 5-10 minutes before  
Malcolm X was introduced. I went to the back & sat in a  
booth from 37 to 43, and smoked a cigaret. Heard shots  
seemed to come from left side of ballroom in front.  
People were running everywhere & he ran out with other  
people. Saw some of the shooters.
